







## FITTING ADVICE


- The shaded areas indicate the clear voids for the running of services
- · This unit is heavy. A secure wall fixing is required
- To aid installation, it is recommended to remove the drawers to give full access and to avoid damage.
- · Recommended height from floor to top of vanity unit carcass is 810mm
- All wall to carcass and wall to basin joints should be sealed with silicone
- · All dimensions are in mm















## **CERAMIC BASINS**


Ceramic Basins are made out of liquefied fireclay which is poured into a mould and allowed to set before being hand finished. A ground glass glaze would typically be sprayed over the basin before the final firing.


This long-lasting, durable material suits a simple and minimalistic bathroom suite as well as a traditional Victorian look. Stains are easily removed and ceramic is generally easy to clean to maintain a shiny appearance. The slight ripples occasionally seen along its surface are often mistaken for flaws these are actually part of the ceramic basins characteristics.











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To aid installation, it is recommended to remove the drawer to give full access and to avoid damage.

- 1. Fit the hanging plate to the wall using suitable fixings for the substrate.
- 2. Hang vanity carcass on the hanging plate and level.
- 3. Second fix through the rear bar locations.
- 4. Silicone around the top of the unit and place basin.
- 5. Silicone around the rear of the unit at wall abutment.
- 6. Re-fit drawer.
